#### IMPORTANT SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

## INSPECTION AND UNPACKING

#### **INSPECTION OF UNIT**

- Inspect the shipping carton and/or container, carefully noting any exterior damage on the delivery receipt
- Note any damage not evident on the outside of the shipping container (concealed damage).
   Contact the carrier immediately and file a damage claim with them.
- Save all packing materials when filing a claim.
   Freight damage claims are the responsibility of the purchaser and are not covered by the warranty.
- Report any dents or breakage to source of purchase immediately.

## CAUTION

Do not attempt to use unit if damaged. UNPACKING UNIT

1. Remove all packing material from the unit.

## CAUTION

2. The feet are set into V-shaped wedges for shipping. Remove all wood pieces from the pallet before trying to lift unit off skid.



3. Set unit on the floor.

**NOTE** You may choose to lay the unit on its back to make working conditions easier for removal of the Door Shipping bracket.

- 4. Using a 5/16" nut driver remove the shipping plate holding the door/s closed.
- 5. Each unit will come with a kick-plate carton.

**NOTE**: Kick-plate instructions are packed with kick-plates.





## **INSTALLATION**

## **Level Unit**

#### Step 1

Place unit on back wall in proper location next to the Refrigerated Base unit.

#### Step 2

Using a pair of channel locks or wrench adjust the legs of the Back Counter to level back counter with the Refrigerated Base unit.



## **Door Adjustment**


#### Step 1

If doors become misaligned during shipment or installation, they may look like this. They can be easily adjusted.



#### Step 2

On the door that is hanging low, tighten hinge screws on top and bottom hinge with a 3/8" open wrench until snug. Do not over tighten.

## Step 3

Place a flat screwdriver against the **outside** of the **bottom** hinge and lightly tap until door is properly aligned.



Tap against bottom of hinge.

**Step 4 - If Required** 

Depending upon the degree of misalignment, it may be necessary to adjust the top hinge as well by gently tapping on the **inside** of the **top** hinge.

Tap against top of hinge.



#### Step 5

Once doors have been aligned, assure all screws are tight on all of the hinges.



## **INSTALLATION - continued**

## **Optional Sink Installation**

## Step 1

If the counter has an optional sink and faucet, Remove sink from box.

## Step 2

Apply Silicone (not included) around bottom edge of sink and set in place.

#### Step 3

Using four (4) wing nuts supplied secure sink to top of counter, and clean up any excess silicone.



## **Optional Faucet Installation**

#### Step 1

Remove faucet from box and install on unit. **Note**: For additional information see instructions with faucet



#### Step 2

Remove control from box to install in cabinet. Use plumbers tape (not included) to wrap all fittings for water lines including the 90 degree elbow.

## **INSTALLATION - continued**

## **Step 3 - Installing Batteries**

First remove the four (4) screws from the cover of the control unit.



**Step 4**First properly place four (4) AA batteries in battery cartridge based on cartridge instructions.



## Step 5 CAUTION

Install battery cartridge in battery compartment making sure the contacts are in the back.





**Step 6**Replace cover on Battery compartment.






## **INSTALLATION - continued**

#### Step 7


Attach the 90° elbow to the cold side of the control. **NOTE**: doing this now will make it easier later. Make sure the elbow is pointed down.



#### Step 8

Using the control as a template mark the hole locations to mount the control.

Control to be mounted on the right side of the sink a minimum of three (3) inches from the top surface and a minimum of one (1) inch from the side panel.



#### Step 9

Connect the faucet supply line from the top of the control to the faucet.



Step 10

Connect the water supply lines from the Hot/Cold sides of the control to the corresponding water supply.



## **Changing Panels**


## **Step 1 - Door Panel**


Use Phillips screw-driver to remove screws from handle and Top and Bottom of door trim. Remove frame and old panel.

## **Step 3- Side Panels**

Remove four (4) screws from rear trim and slide Formica out the back of the unit.

Insert new Formica and re-attach trim.





**Step 2**Replace with new panel and re-install frame with screws and handle.
