





Pickup Shelving Installation


ACAUTION Mounting clips are intended to provide stability. Unit should not hang from clips but stand on legs locked into the mounting clips so the shelving won't tip.

Step 1 Installing Clips

Install top clips with appropriate

fastener for wall material (#10 screws into studs etc.)

- Place mounting clip so the bottom flange "hooks" onto the riser of the back counter (if applicable).
- Make sure all brackets face the same direction with the open side.
- Mark holes to drill
- 15.5" spacing horizontal from first pilot hole for the second hole (roughly 40"-42" above finished floor)
- Upper pilot holes (size to be determined on site for studs or drywall anchors) should be approximately 73"-75" above finished floor when installed on 36" tall back counter.





Pickup Shelving Installation - continued

Step 2 Mounting the Shelving Bottom

- Loosen front set screws (red arrows).
- Position the shelving into the bottom brackets.


Make sure shelf unit is sitting solid on the top.


Note: Make sure led lights are to the front of the unit.


Step 3 Mounting the Shelving Top

The shelving can then be placed into the top brackets through the open side of top brackets.

- Once the shelf is placed inside the brackets, use the front set screws to lock the post into place against the "back stop"
- Tighten screws on all 4 brackets.
- Use Rubber Caps to cover bolt heads.










Pickup Shelving Installation - continued


Step 4 Power to LED Lighting


- Lighting is provided for the shelving with led lights on each shelf and a low voltage transformer.
- Run power cord to receptacle avoiding sharp edges and pinch points.
- Lights are mounted on the front of the unit to shine from the customer's perspective.
- The power cable is located on the bottom side of the lowest shelf.






Free Standing Pickup Shelf Specifications
